

SALE/AUCTION OF THE FOODGRAINS (Rice, Wheat and Sugar)

The Department of Food & Supplies and Consumer Affairs and Legal Metrology, Sector-17, U.T., Chandigarh has implemented the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) scheme under NFSA, 2013 for foodgrains. Now, the Department intends to sale following balance foodgrains lying at PR Godown, Plot No. 23, Industrial Area, Phase-I, Chandigarh on dated 02.03.2016 at 11:30 a.m.

The terms and conditions for the auction/sale are given below:-

1. Auction will be held on "AS IS WHERE IS BASIS".
2. Deposit of earnest money of **Rs. 25,000/-** in cash or in the shape of Demand Draft in the favour of District Food & Supplies Officer, U.T., Chandigarh.
3. The foodgrains will be sold to the highest bidder, subject to final approval of the competent authority.
4. The approval of lifting foodgrains will be granted only after the successful bidder/s submit the full payment in the form of Bank Draft, within the next two working days otherwise late charges shall also be levied @ Rs.500/- per day.
5. The successful bidder will have to lift the foodgrains at his own cost within five days after the approval of lifting the foodgrains, otherwise godown charges shall also be levied @ Rs. 500/- per day.
6. The bidder shall have to submit his/her photo identity proof of residence (Aadhar Card, Voter Card, Pan Card or any other authentic proof) to the Department before participating in the auction.
7. The base price of the foodgrains to be auctioned will be conveyed to the bidders on the same day of the auction.
8. The earnest money deposited before the start of the auction shall be adjusted with balance amount of highest bid.
9. The earnest money deposited before the start of auction shall be returned back to other bidders, accept the highest bidder and second highest bidder after the auction is completed.
10. The successful bidder/s will have to lift the foodgrains with the prior approval of the Department. The office will not be responsible for any delay/lapse on his part in this regard.
11. The highest bidder will not be allowed to withdraw their bids under any circumstances otherwise their earnest money will be forfeited.
12. The decision of the auction committee will be final.
13. The Department reserves the rights to postpone/cancel the auction and to accept or reject the highest bidder without assigning any reason thereof.
